**ENTRIES/FEES:**

- A. **FEE:** \$25.00 per test.
- B. Make checks payable to: **AEA**
- C. **REFUND POLICY:** Full refund less \$20 handling fee before closing date. **NO REFUNDS AFTER CLOSING DATE** unless management cancels the show for inclement weather or other emergencies, in which case monies will be credited towards another show or refunded.
- D. **COGGINS:** Negative Coggins within 24 months if in-state, 12 months if out of state. Coggins **MUST** accompany entry.
- E. **CLOSING DATE:** Entries must be postmarked **BY** closing date. Entries received after the closing date are subject to a \$10.00 post-entry fee, if space permits. Email entries accepted as long as payment is mailed in a timely manner.
- F. **NON-NEGOTIABLE CHECK** will void entry and incur a \$50.00 fee.
- G. **POST-ENTRIES:** accepted on day of show if space permits at \$30.00 per test.

**WARM-UP:** Ride times will be scheduled as to allow warm-up in the indoor arena. If weather permits, warm-up may be held in grass outdoor ring.

**STABLING FEES:** Day dry stalls available - \$20.00. Stalls must be cleaned and all manure must be removed from grounds by competitors. \$10.00 will be refunded if stall is cleaned.

- *Show management will charge \$20.00 additional clean up fee per stall additional if bedding, hay, or manure is not removed.*

**SHOW AWARDS:** Day of show awards will be done by level, not individual tests. Prizes to be given to high score of the level.

**SERIES AWARDS:** Series awards will be based on the average of the three highest scores, including at least one score from the highest test for a given level (i.e.: Intro B, Training 1, Training Level Test 3, etc.) for a horse and rider combination. All other scores to be dropped. To be eligible, you must attend at least TWO shows and compete in at least three tests at a given level with at least one of those tests being the highest test for that level.

**LEVELS FOR SHOW AND SERIES AWARDS:** Intro A & B Combined, Pre-Training (Intro C & Training 1), Training Level (ALL tests), First Level, Second Level, Third Level and above, Western Dressage (combined) and Eventing (combined).

**NJQHA HIGH POINT WESTERN DRESSAGE AWARD:** Prize to be provided by NJQHA. To be awarded to the registered QH with highest score in the Western Dressage classes for the complete show series. **To be eligible** a copy of AQHA registration papers **MUST** be submitted with entry.

**ARENA:** Classes may be held in either a small or large arena in the Indoor arena – sand fiber and rubber footing.

**RIDE TIMES:** Times will be posted the Wednesday prior to each show at [www.aeanj.com](http://www.aeanj.com).

**NON-SHOWING HORSES:** Due to the ring set-up at AEA non-showing horses are welcome to be stalled during the show and ridden after the show is over. Current Coggins must be provided, and \$20 stall fee must be paid for each non-showing horse and the rider must sign a release upon arrival.

**OTHER:** Food and beverages available on premises in heated viewing room. All dogs **MUST** be on a leash at all times! Please call secretary for info on schooling horses. Please state on entry form any special considerations; i.e. trailering with other competitors, multiple horses entered, etc. Please return bridle numbers at the end of the show.

**HOLD HARMLESS CLAUSE:** Understanding that horse sports may be hazardous, possibly leading to permanent injury or death, each owner, rider, spectator, and other participants assumes any and all risk, loss, or injury and agrees to hold harmless, regardless of negligent acts or omissions the Alexandria Equestrian Association, Alexandria Township and its officers and employees, show committee, and all horse show personnel.

**IN CASE OF INCLEMENT WEATER,** the decision to cancel the show will be determined by noon the prior day. A notice will be posted on the [www.aeanj.com](http://www.aeanj.com) website and competitors will be notified via email.
